

To all IAM Members:

My name is Jason Redrup, and I currently serve as a Business Rep for IAM District 751 in Everett, WA representing members at Boeing. I respectfully request your help during the upcoming IAM election process. I hope you will consider nominating myself and the IAM reform ticket for leadership positions on Jan. 25 to help change the direction of the IAM and restore democracy to our great union.

Before introducing our candidates, I want to tell you why I decided to run on the IAM Reform ticket.

Earlier this month, members at District 751 endured a devastating loss to our solidarity and the benefits we had fought decades to secure. If what happened at 751 goes unchallenged, it will set a dangerous pattern for other contracts across the country. My goal is to ensure what happened in Seattle, doesn't happen to another group of Machinists.

Even though we had a contract in place through 2016 and our District strongly objected, our International ordered a vote on a concessionary offer be held on Jan. 3rd knowing thousands of union members would be on vacation and unable to vote. This vote was ordered after many members had already begun their holidays, and the International refused to move the vote just one business day. With nearly 8,000 members not voting, we are now forced to live under a contract that eliminated pensions for all, more than doubles health care costs, slows wage growth by 75 percent and keeps us from returning to the bargaining table until 2024. This came not when Boeing was hurting, but enjoying record profits and backlogs.

This was wrong and must not happen elsewhere. All of us got involved in the union because we wanted to make a difference and give workers a voice; now it's time to use your voice. We will be nominating international officers on January 25, 2014, since the previous election was overturned due to irregularities.

I, along with my slate of candidates, believe it is time to change the direction of the IAM. We want to give every member a voice and a vote in our union. **Help us ensure members get to vote on our International leadership by nominating IAM reform candidates so we can have our first election since 1961.** The IAM Constitution requires we must be endorsed by 25 local lodges to be placed on the national ballot.

Join us in this effort, and nominate our slate of candidates at your local on Jan. 25.

A member can nominate one or no candidate for Int'l President, one or no candidate for General Secretary-Treasurer, and up to eight candidates for General Vice Presidents. Lodges may nominate a mix of incumbent and Reform candidates but must nominate one candidate for Int'l President, one for General Secretary-Treasurer, and 8 General VP's. If lodges receive competing nominations for each office on Jan. 25, they will hold a vote Feb. 8 to determine the lodge's endorsements for the 10 positions.
